There are prerequisites for this programme that must be met in order to progress through the qualification.

An appropriate HEQSF Level 7 Bachelor's degree; OR
An appropriate Advanced Diploma; OR
An equivalent NQF Level 7 qualification

Notes:

The qualification must include public health, medical or nursing-related modules at the 3rd-year level, or the applicant must have a minimum of 3 years' experience in a public health related field

Senate Discretionary Admission

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Where candidates do not satisfy the formal admission requirements for this qualification, The IIE may consider an admission application in terms of the Credit Accumulation and Transfer, Recognition of Prior Learning and Qualification Completion Policy (IIE010).
