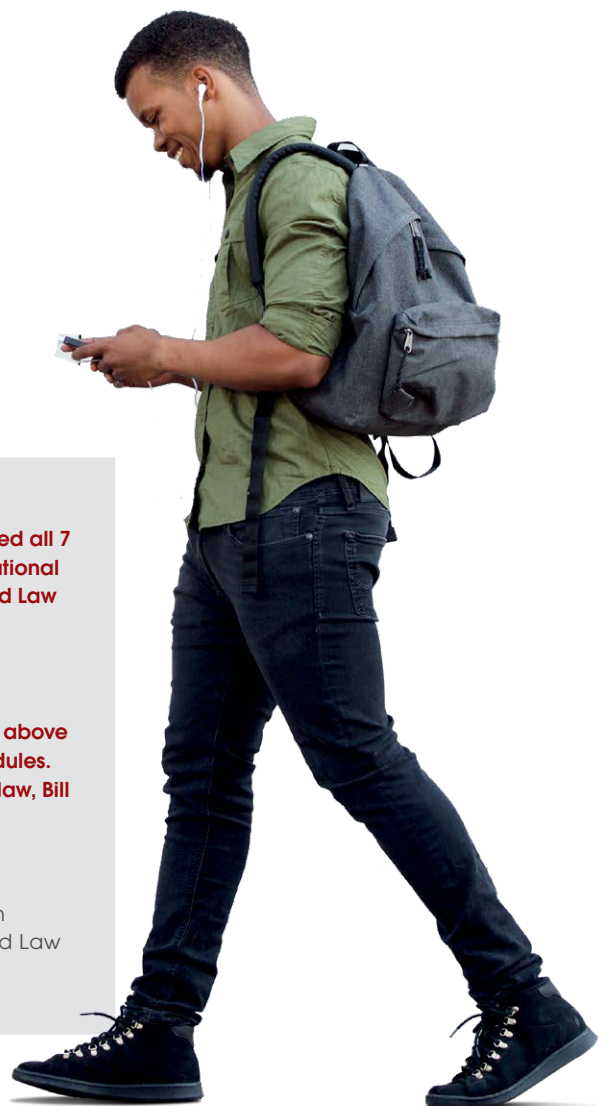
ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

An appropriate HEQSF Level 7 Bachelor's degree and completed all 7 relevant prerequisite Law subjects: Introduction to law, Constitutional law, Contract law, Criminal law, Bill of rights, Law of persons and Law of family OR

Alternatively: A student with an HEQSF Level 7 or equivalent qualification that does not have all 7 of the Law subjects listed above may be admitted, subject to the completion of additional modules. (Introduction to law, Constitutional law, Contract law, Criminal law, Bill of rights, Law of persons and Law of family)

International

A SAQA Evaluation Certificate with NQF L7 equivalence in an appropriate field AND have completed all 7 relevant required Law subjects.
