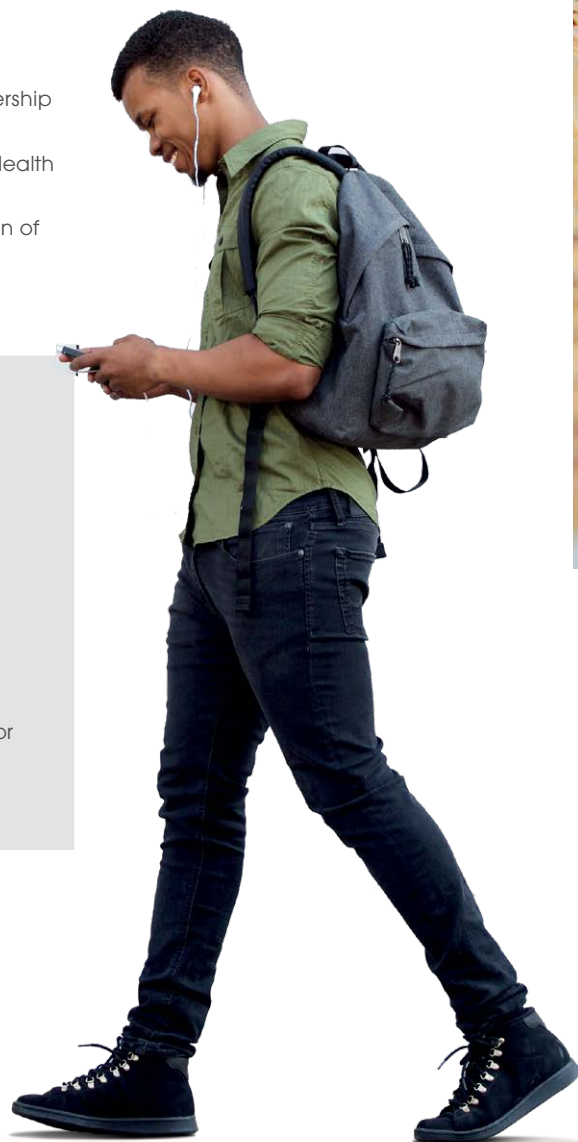
ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
